

SUMMER 2021 STUDENT WORKER OPPORTUNITIES

The Institutional and Federal Work-Study program provides jobs for full-time students, allowing the opportunity to earn money to help pay educational expenses.

In order to qualify, students must be full-time and have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). If the position is a Federal work-study position, students must demonstrate financial aid by meeting criteria determined by the Federal Government. Eligibility for work-study does not guarantee that you will be hired. If the student is selected, and it is a Federal work-study position, the hiring supervisor will work with Financial Aid to ensure the student qualifies.

A list of available work-study opportunities is enclosed. If you are interested in one of these positions, complete the application provided on the last page and email it to supervisor listed beside the desired position.

The supervisor will review the applications and interview potential students to fill the position. Successful applicants, who will be notified, must complete additional paperwork.
