

Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund – Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

Quarterly Report as of March 31, 2022

Congress passed the American Rescue Plan (ARP), Public Law 117-2, which was enacted on March 11, 2021. It will deliver emergency assistance to Itawamba Community College in the form of funds to be used to cover expenses related to the disruption of college operations due to the Coronavirus.

The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (HEERF III) is authorized by the ARP, which provides emergency financial assistance to eligible students, and it may assist with expenses such as food, housing, course materials, technology, healthcare and childcare. These funds, however, are not intended to replace income or pay for student expenses that are not related to the disruption of college operations due to COVID-19.

On behalf of Itawamba Community College, I acknowledge that ICC plans to use no less than fifty (50) percent of the funds received from the ARP to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

The deadline to complete the FAFSA is November 5, 2021.

Refunds will be sent to BankMobile[™] for processing no later than Friday, November 19, 2021.

Students are encouraged to set up a refund method with BankMobile[™] prior to November 5, 2021, if they have not previously done so.
